Topic

What's the best building you've been to? Describe it, and say why you like it.

Word Limit

Open: up to 1500
Secondary School: up to 800

Entry Criteria

An essay must address the set topic, must be wholly the work of the person submitting it, and must not have been published previously.

Prizes

Open category winner: \$2000
Secondary School category winner: \$1000
Highly Commended: \$500*
*up to three Highly Commended Awards will be made
