First Prize, Secondary School Student category..... \$1000  
Highly Commended (3 prizes across both categories)..... \$500

## Entry format

Email your essay as a Word document; text only (no illustrations or images). Your essay should have a title, but do not put your name on the essay; include your name and address, and the name of your school (if you are entering in the Secondary School category), in your email message.

## The Prize-winners will be announced at the end of September 2019


